EU taxonomy increases pressure on companies to act

As a European regulatory instrument, the EU taxonomy sets criteria for assessing the sustainability of economic processes and financial products. The aim is to align investments and capital flows more closely with environmental considerations. The taxonomy will also gradually introduce a reporting obligation for companies: Currently, this already applies to large listed companies and financial service providers. By 2026, however, the obligation to report on sustainability in accordance with the taxonomy will also be extended to a large number of other companies.
